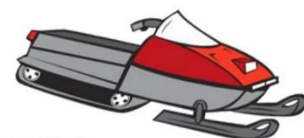

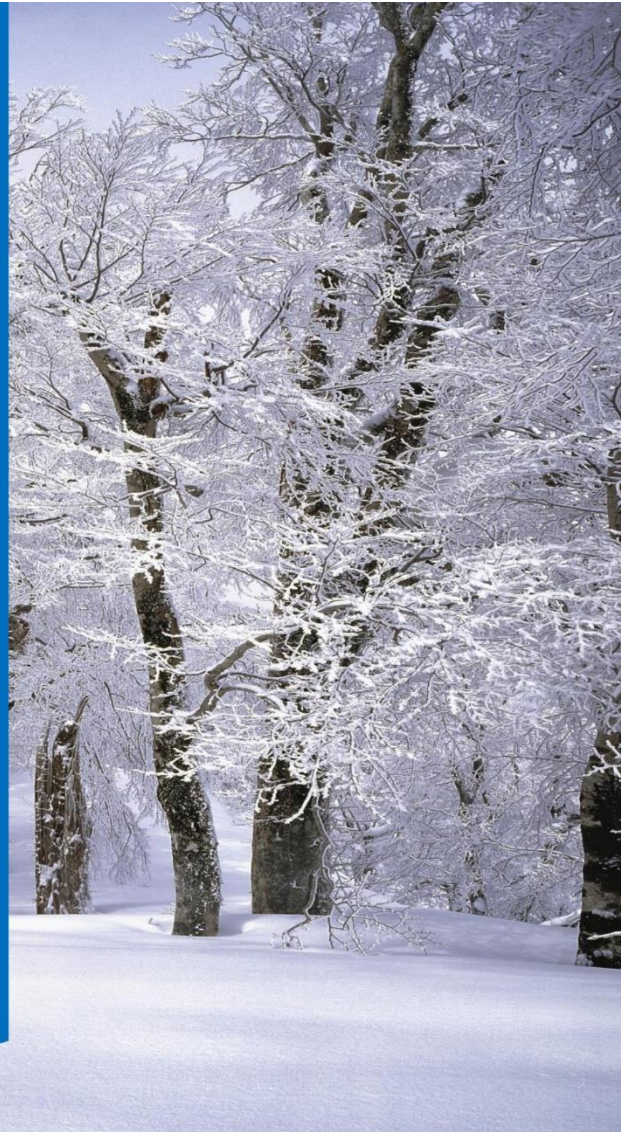

Annual Membership Renewal
